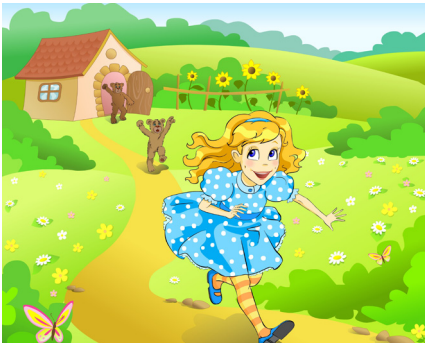
PLANNING

We have split the activities into weeks, there are 7 weeks in this term and we used the first week for settling the children back in to the routine. As well as these topics we will also be following the children's own individual interests

and learning on a weekly basis.

WEEK 2 AND 3

Last week and this week we are looking at Goldilocks and the 3 bears, focusing on developing the children's number skills, comparing sizes and imaginative play.

We will be having a teddy bears picnic on Thursday 20th Jan., so your child can bring a bear from home and we will make teddy biscuits, sandwiches etc., to eat at the picnic.



WEEK 3 AND 4

The children have shown interest in the 3 little pigs story so we will focus on lots of things related to building, making and constructing. We thought it might be fun to have a builders yard outside, with wet sand trowels tools etc., if anyone has anything to give us or any ideas to develop this please let us know.



WEEK 5

To continue with traditional stories we will look at the 3 billygoats gruff where we will be focusing on lots of over, under, inside, on top etc., to develop the children's speech and language skills. Jayne is going to bring her balance beam in which she uses in her gymnastic class on a Saturday. We will use this as a bridge and do lots of balancing and climbing.



WEEK 6

Chinese New Year begins so we will be doing lots of things to help the children recognize different cultures and traditions.

WEEK 7

Valentines Day; we will be looking at heart shapes and focusing on the colour pink and red for this week. In this last week we will be inviting parents to come in to pre-school look at your child's progress file and talk to their key worker about all the lovely things your child has done. This will only take about ten minutes at the most and we will ask parents to choose a time and day to come in. If this is not possible for some then let us know and we will try to arrange another time. Parents can then take their files home for over the holidays. *A notice for you to tick time and day will go on the wall.*

NOTICE BOARD

The pre-school notice board in school is not really being used as parents do not come through that way now, so we will be looking to change that and have it somewhere in the hall, this will also include a staff information board with photos of the wraparound team including the committee, who play an important part in keeping everything ticking over.
