Events/Christmas Crafts/Fun

Physical Development Movement and handling	What we will offer the children/how we may meet the targets.
<p>22-36 months Climbs confidently and begins to pull themselves up on nursery play equipment. Can Kick a large ball. Shows control on using jugs to pour, books and mark making tools. Imitates drawing simple shapes e.g. circles and lines. Beginning to use three fingers (tripod grip) to hold writing tools.</p> <p>30-50 months Moves freely and with pleasure and confidence in a variety of ways such as slithering, shuffling, rolling, crawling etc. Draws lines and circles using gross motor movements. Uses one handed tools and equipment e.g. makes snips in paper. Can copy some letters from name.</p> <p>40-60 months + Experiments with different ways of moving. Negotiates space successfully when playing adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles. Uses simple tools to effect changes to materials. Handles tools and malleable materials with increasing control. Begins to form recognisable letters.</p>	<p>During each session we will offer the children time to play outside weather permitting they will be able to use the climbing frame, slide and see saw this will encourage them to climb and pull themselves up. They will also be able to explore moving in various ways outside running, hopping jumping etc. There are always balls hoops and bats as well as pedal bikes available.</p> <p>Each session we offer a craft/writing table to encourage the children to draw and use mark making equipment this includes paint as well as pens we also encourage mark making in shaving foam and corn flour gloop. Sand and water trays will be offered along with dried rice and pasta to encourage pouring and filling.</p> <p>The free craft table also had scissors available and we also have teaching scissors to help those younger children.</p> <p>During most sessions we have play dough available and offer other malleable things already mentioned along with rolling pins, cutters and other tools to encourage children control.</p> <p>We will also be having fun making lots of crafts related to Christmas.</p>
