Communication and Language Speaking	What we will offer the children/how we may meet the targets.
<p>22-36 months</p> <p>Uses language to widen contacts, share feelings, ideas and thoughts.</p> <p>Holds a conversation jumping from topic to topic.</p> <p>Learns new words rapidly and is able to use them.</p> <p>Uses simple sentences Mummy gone work.</p> <p>Uses gestures with limited talk e.g. reaches for toy "I have it"</p> <p>Uses a variety of questions.</p> <p>30-50 months</p> <p>Beginning to use more complex sentences to link thoughts using (and) and (because)</p> <p>Can retell a past event in the correct order.</p> <p>Use talk to connect ideas explain what is happening what might happen and recall experiences.</p> <p>Builds up vocab that reflects the breath of their experiences.</p> <p>Questions why things happen and give explanations.</p> <p>40-60 months +</p> <p>Uses language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations.</p> <p>Introduces a storyline or narrative into their play.</p>	<p>We will encourage the children to talk about things they have been up too by asking them during circle time or snack time e.g. what have you done at the weekend?</p> <p>Encourage the children to talk and tell you things during times when working with them encourage them to tell you what they have made or draw for example.</p> <p>Give them time to talk to you and be prepared to listen and respond.</p> <p>Provide time and toys for role playing to encourage using vocab to reflect experiences and imaginative and pretend play.</p> <p>We will be encouraging all children to be confident to talk during circle time and use share bear to reinforce rules of speaking and listening eg when X has the bear it is their turn to speak and our turn to listen.</p> <p>As part of the topic on events/Christmas we will be asking the children about events they have been too e.g. Bonfire night, birthday parties encouraging them to retell events they may remember about them.</p>
