This will be charged at normal afterschool rates plus £1.00 to cover the cost of ingredients.

Thursdays- Arts and crafts with Caroline and Jayne.

We may change activities throughout the term to accommodate numbers etc. We will let you know in advance of any changes.

Usual rates apply and after school runs as normal alongside this.

In addition to these sessions the children have a wide choice of activities in afterschool including dough, sand, water, construction, role play etc and we also plan adult led activities e.g. arts and craft which we will use for displays in school.

The children each have an afterschool journal which they can write in and add photographs of their after school activities. These can be taken home regularly to let you see what we do and for you to add any views, ideas or comments.

We are always looking for new ideas for afterschool so please let us know the kind of things your child likes to do.

There will also be a bingo night on **Monday 11th February** (please see a member of staff for further details.)

School Closure Procedure for Pre-school/Afterschool.

In the event of the school closing due to severe weather or any other unexpected reason the following procedures will be followed:

The Wraparound leader will confirm with the head teacher that school is closed. This will be done by 7.30 on the first day of school closing. via email or telephone.

The Wraparound leader will have a copy of parents contact details at home incase of such events occurring.

Parents will be contacted individually with information regarding the closure. If your details change please let us know as soon as possible so we can update our records.

Parents should be aware of weather news throughout the day and check regularly for texts and e-mails.

Parents will then be advised to check the school website. Parents are also advised to check the wraparound email daily and www.northumberland.gov.uk which will give up to date information on when the school will re-open.
