Reminder!

Please can you ensure that ALL your children's clothes are named as all the children wear the same coloured clothing and they get upset when they can't find their clothes.

Please ensure that school bags are always in school containing reading books, reading records, spelling books and homework.

Every child should have a P.E. kit in school at all times including sandshoes or trainers that fit. Please make sure shorts, tee shirts and sandshoes are all named. Can you please make sure that your child's indoor shoes fit them properly. Children's feet grow very quickly especially regarding sandshoes.

We only have milk and water for break times. Sorry no juice allowed. Can you ensure your child's water bottle is brought to school every day.

If your child has been sick or had diarrhoea please wait 48 hours before sending them back to school.

Our children need to be kept safe at all times. We therefore ask you not to open our doors to anyone, this must be done by a member of staff.

We would also like to stress that if you are the last person delivering children to school in the morning please ensure the door is locked when you leave. Please can you make sure the yard gate and the car park gate are locked at all times.

Could you please remind your child that football boots are not allowed to be worn indoors or on the climbing frame.

In view of current events could parents please ensure that young children are never left unsupervised on the school site. There is no safe place.
