Children's safety at School

Reminder!

Please ensure that school bags are always in school containing reading books, reading records, spelling books and homework. Could you please ensure that you read with your child every night. Please check your child's bag each night for letters and important information .

Every child should have a P.E. kit in school at all times including sandshoes or trainers that fit. Please make sure shorts, tee shirts and sandshoes are all named.

We only have milk and water for break times. Sorry, no juice allowed. Can you ensure your child's water bottle is brought to school every day.

Our children need to be kept safe at all times. We therefore ask you not to open our doors to anyone, this must be done by a member of staff. Could parents please ensure that young children are never left unsupervised on the school site. There is no safe place. Can we please remind parents that children must be escorted into school and not dropped off in the car park to walk into school on their own.

We would also like to stress that if you are the last person delivering children to school in the morning please ensure the door is locked when you leave. Please can you make sure the yard gate and the car park gate are locked at all times.

If your child has been sick or had diarrhoea please wait 48 hours before sending them back to school.

Good attendance is very important for your child to ensure they receive the best education possible. However if your child is going to be absent from school could you please phone Mrs. Flatman before 10am to let us know. Holidays in term time should be avoided at all costs!
